Objective: To celebrate International Yoga Day and spread awareness about benefits about Yoga on health.

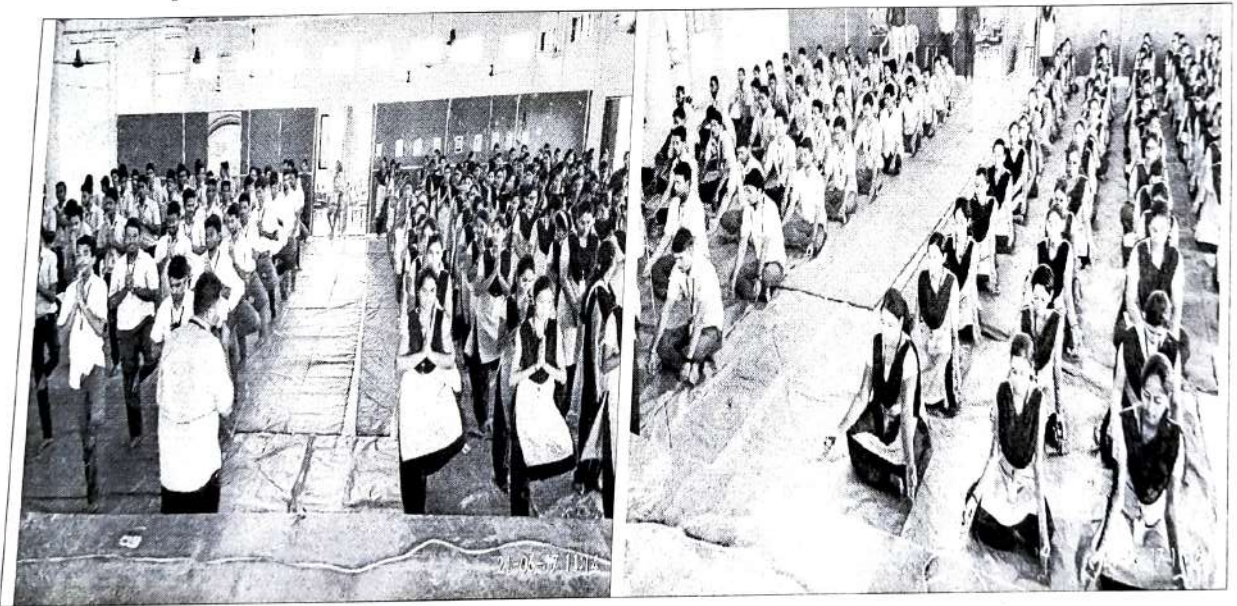
Brief Summary of Report:

Objective: To make people aware about traffic rules.

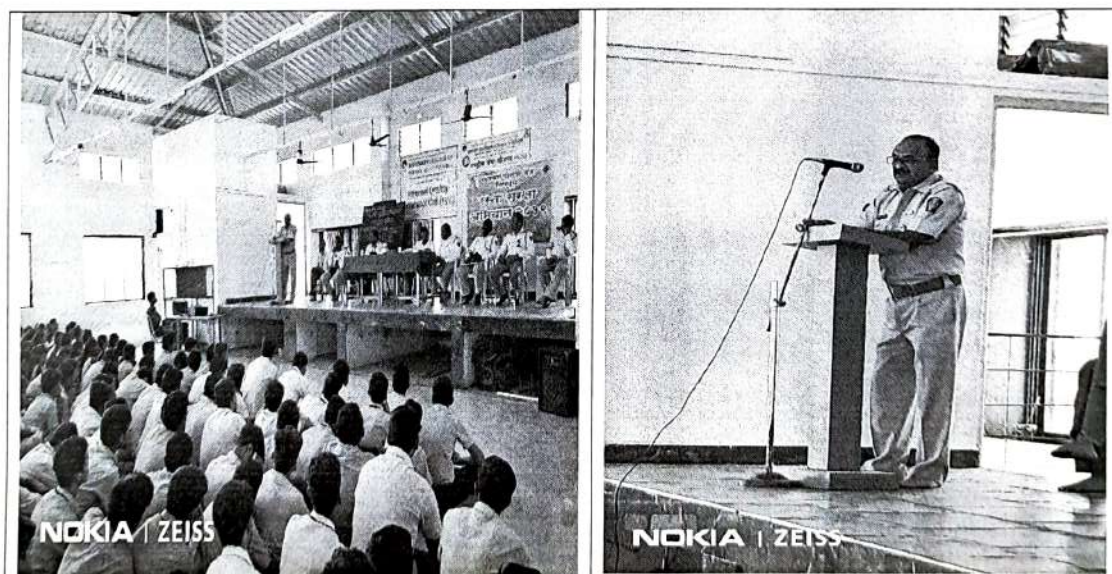
Brief Summary of Report:
