The Constitution of Selection Committee for the post of **Principal and Librarian** as per the UGC notification, the Government Resolution, Higher & Technical Education Dept. No. Misc-2018/C.R.56/18/UNI-1, dated 8th March, 2019 and University Circular Nos. TAAS (CT)/ICD/2018-19/ 1241, dated 26th March, 2019, TAAS(CT)/ICD/05/2019-2020 dated 14/06/2019 & TAAS(CT)/ICD/08/2019-2020 dated 4th July, 2019 and corrigendum issued by Government under reference no. Misc-2018/C.R.56/18/UNI-1, dated 10th May, 2019 is as under:-

- a) Selection Committee for the post of **Principal** in Colleges including Private Colleges shall have the following composition:
- 1) Chairperson of the Governing Body to be the **Chairperson**.
 - 2) Two members of the Governing Body of the college to be nominated by the Chairperson of whom one shall be an expert in academic administration.
 - 3) Two nominees of the Vice-Chancellor who shall be Higher Education experts in the subject/field concerned out of which at least one shall be a person not connected in any manner with the affiliating University. In case of Colleges notified/declared as minority educational institutions, one nominee of the Chairperson of the college from out of a panel of five names, preferably from minority communities, recommended by the Vice Chancellor of the affiliation University of whom one should be a subject expert.

- 4) Three Higher Education experts consisting of the Principal of a college, a Professor and an accomplished educationist not below the rank of a Professor (or be nominated by the Governing Body of the college out of a panel of six experts approved by the relevant statutory body of the University concerned).
- 5) An academician representing SC/ST/OBC/Minority/Women/Differently-able categories, if any of candidates representing these categories is the applicant, to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor, if any of the above members of the selection committee does not belong to that category.
- 6) Two subject-experts not connected with the college to be nominated by the Chairperson of the governing body of the college out of a panel of five names recommended by the Vice Chancellor from the list of subject experts approved by the relevant statutory body of the university concerned. In case of colleges notified/declared as minority educational institutions, two subject experts not connected with the University nominated by the Chairperson of the College governing body out of the panel of five names, preferably from minority communities, recommended by the Vice Chancellor from the list of subject experts approved by the relevant statutory body.
- 7) The Director, Higher Education or his nominee not below the rank of Professor/Principal, in Case of post is on grant-in-aid basis;

“The quorum of the meeting shall be five members, of whom at least two shall be from out of three subject expert and Joint Director, Higher Education or his/her nominee.”

B) Selection Committee for the post of Librarian in Colleges including Private Colleges shall have the following composition:

1. Chairperson of the Governing Body of the College or his/her nominee from the among the members of the Governing body, who shall be the Chairperson of the Committee.
2. The Principal of the College.
3. Head of the Department/Teacher-in-charge of the subject concerned in the college.
4. Two nominees of the Vice-Chancellor of the affiliating University of whom one should be a subject expert. In case of colleges notified/declared as minority educational institutions, two nominees of the chairperson of the college from out of a panel of five names, preferably from minority communities, recommended by the Vice Chancellor of the affiliating University, from the list of experts suggested by the relevant statutory body of the college, of whom one should be a subject expert.
5. Two subject experts not connected with the College who shall be nominated by the Chairperson of the College Governing body out of a panel of five names recommended by the Vice-Chancellor from the list of subject expert approved by the relevant statutory body of the University concerned. In case of colleges notified/declared as minority educational institutions, two subject experts not connected with the University nominated by the Chairperson of the Governing Body of the College out of the panel of five names, preferably from the minority communities, recommended by the Vice-Chancellor from the list of subject expert approved by the relevant statutory body of the college.

6. An academician representing SC/ST/OBC/Minority/Women/Differently-able categories, if any of candidates belonging to any of these categories is the applicant, to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor, if any of the above members of the selection committee does not belong to that category.
7. The Joint Director, Higher Education of the region or his nominee not below the rank of Associate Professor, if the post is on grant-in aid basis.

“The quorum of the meeting shall be five members, of whom at least two shall be from out of three subject expert and Joint Director, Higher Education or his/her nominee.”

Please note that the appointment for the post of Principal is a tenure post of five years or till the age of superannuation whichever is earlier.


Further, you are required to invite the Vice-Chancellor's nominee as the member of scrutiny committee to scrutinize the applications received for the post of Principal for calculating the minimum research score of 110 as stipulated in the API based on PBAS, the minimum of 10 research publications in peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals & other related aspects and submit the Scrutiny Committee report to the University alongwith the Selection Committee report. If you fail to invite the Vice-Chancellor's nominee for the scrutiny of the applications and for the selection committee, the entire selection procedure will be treated as null & void, which may please be noted.

Further, you are required to follow the University Circular No. TAAS(CT)/05/ of 2019-2020 dated 14th June, 2019 for filling post of Principal in your college.

Also you are requested to submit the original full page of the newspaper in which the advertisement is published at the time of asking for the Vice-Chancellor's nominee and subject expert/s for the Selection Committee or at the time of submission of seven pages report.

Also you are requested to remit the requisite amount per subject per designation as mentioned in the University circular No. टीएएस(सीटी)/०२/२०१७ — २०१८, दिनांक ६ मे, २०१७ online at the earliest.


